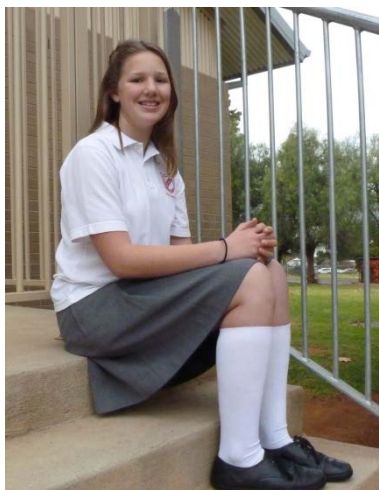
Tennis Hot Shots Program
