<u>**3-6 Aidan (3A)**</u> for being a caring person who shows respect to teachers and students.




Welcome Back to Term 4

Entry to Government Selective High Schools for Year 7 in 2020

Parents or carers of Year 5 students who wish their child to be considered for placement in Year 7 at a selective high school in 2020 need to apply now.

Important information:

- Parents must apply online at <u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.</u>
- Applications for entry in 2017 can be made online between 9 October 2018 and 12 November 2018.
- All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday 14 March 2019.
- Aurora College is a selective virtual secondary school. With Aurora, students attend their local high/central school and connect with specialist classes and teachers in English, Mathematics and Science. It means that they do not have to leave home, or school, to access extension opportunities. Parents may consider their children sitting the selective test to keep their options open in 2020.
